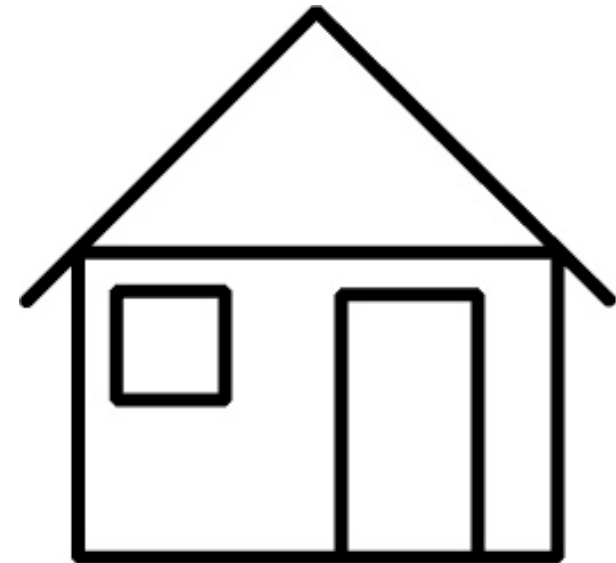

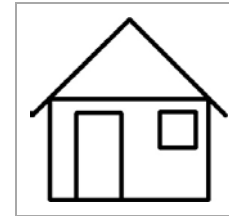

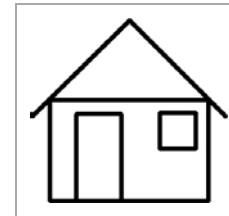
What We Do

Strategic Planning



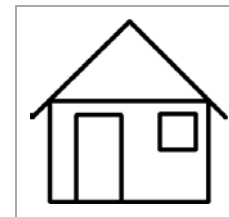
Chittenden County Homeless Alliance members have worked together for years to develop a strategic plan which envisions a community where homelessness will be virtually nonexistent. We are now putting this plan into action. We welcome your help to tackle this challenging and rewarding work!

Coordinated Entry



The CCHA is implementing a system of “coordinated entry” to ensure that anyone who experiences homelessness in our community can easily get connected to all resources and help that they are eligible for.

Distribute Funding



The CCHA is the entity that applies for federal funding to address homelessness within Chittenden County, Vermont. Any awarded funds are distributed between various local groups, as determined by an application and ranking process.
