

EFFORTS TO ASSIST IN THIS TRANSITION:

- Team Based Care (also referred to as Complex Care Housing Resource Teams)
 - Began in November of 2022
 - Working to ensure integration with Coordinated Entry
- Community Housing Case Managers have been key to the success of this work, and their efforts are deeply appreciated.

EFFORTS TO ASSIST IN THIS TRANSITION:

- Letter of Interest.
 - Multi-agency Housing Team will vet these proposals and identify a pathway
 - Sent out broadly to communities to requests proposals for working together to serve those whose hotel stays are no longer paid for
- These letters are being considered now
 - Over 50 Letters of Interest were Received
 - Communities will start to hear from the appropriate agencies soon

EFFORTS TO ASSIST IN THIS TRANSITION:

- Request for Proposal
 - Seeking contracts to support staffing at congregate, semi-congregate and existing shelters
- Responses due June 11th
