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Five Principles for the Use of Funds from Opioid Litigation

Adhere to the five principles for the use of funds from opioid litigation (Johns Hopkins):

- 1. Spend the money on the crisis-supplement, not supplant, don't spend all at once.
- 2. Use evidence to guide spending.
- 3. Invest in youth prevention.
- 4. Focus on (racial) equity especially geographic
- 5. Public health leadership should guide a fair and transparent process to decide spending actively engage key groups and lived experience.

Use of 2023 Opioid Settlement Monies

Harm Reduction

- Naloxone distribution expansion \$1,980,000
- Fentanyl and Xylazine test strips \$200,000
- Wound care telehealth consultation pilot \$100,000
- Contingency management for stimulant use disorder \$840,000
- Drug-checking service \$700,000

Enhanced Access to the Treatment System

- Opioid medication dosing units (satellites) \$2,000,000
- Outreach workers \$1,976,000
