Daystation

- Noontime meal, showers, laundry, connection to services and community partners such as BHA, CHCB, Turning Point, VA, Working Fields and Dr. Pepper Keurig, Opportunities, DOL, Pathways VT Associates, Howard Center.
- 515 unique visitors July through September 2023
- Average per day 63 with a high of 80.
- Of those guests:
 - o 63% unsheltered (outside)
 - o 22% Waystation
 - o 5% housed
 - o 5% Champlain Inn
 - 2% couch surfing
 - o 2% motel
 - o 1% Anew Place

Waystation Shelter

October 2022 -September 2023 COTS Fiscal Year

- 183 unique individuals
- 42 Chronically Homeless
- 30 permanent housing placements.
- 36 beds currently full

Smith House Step-Up Shelter

October 2022 -September 2023 COTS Fiscal Year

- 25 Unique individuals
- 18 intakes during FY
- 13 permanent housing placements
- 7 beds currently full

Family Shelter

October 2022 -September 2023 COTS Fiscal Year

- 29 Households
- 7 Chronically Homeless
- 35 Adults 53 kids
- 15 permanent housing placements (average stay 6 months)
- 15 rooms current full 16 families on the waitlist

Motel Outreach

October 2022- September 2023 COTS Fiscal Year

- 173 Households
- 212 adults 87 kids
- 45 permanent housing placements
- Currently working with 76 households in motels; 50 of those June cohort

Across COTS programs 105 permanent housing placements COTS Fiscal Year 23.
